

ORDINANCE NO. 694

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS, CONCERNING THE REGULATION OF THE STORAGE OF INOPERABLE VEHICLES AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1. Original Section 6 of Ordinance 635 as adopted by the City of Sedgwick, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:**

**SECTION 6. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more then \$500.00, plus \$25.00 per day for each day the violation continues. Additionally, the City, through law enforcement and its appointed agents, may choose to notify the owner of the abandoned/inoperable vehicle located on public right of way or publicly owned property that the vehicle will be impounded at the end of seventy-two (72) hours at the expense of the rightful owner. Such notice shall be conspicuously posted upon the abandoned/inoperable vehicle and delivered to the last known address of the rightful owner.**

**SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in THE HARVEY COUNTY INDEPENDENT, the official newspaper of said City.**
