SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication in the Sedgwick Pantagraph, the official newspaper of said City.

hereby determines and declares that the reasonable and safe speed limit on said streets is Twenty (20) miles per hour. This four (4) block area surrounds the City of Sedgwick's City Park.

Madison between 4th and 5th Streets
Franklin between 4th and 5th Streets
4th Street between Madison and Franklin
5th Street between Madison and Franklin

SECTION 1: The Governing Body having determined upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed limit permitted under state law and Section *33 of the Standard Traffic Ordinance is greater than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist upon the following streets:
